1	<b>CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS</b>
	Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted no later than 60 minutes before it takes effect, with exception that any change in the race schedule will be posted by 21.00 on the day before it comes into effect.
2	<b>SIGNALS MADE ASHORE</b>
	<p>2.1 Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagpole which is located in YC Dyje 2.2 Signals for course Alpha will be displayed below a white flag with the letter A. Znamení pro okruh alfa budou vyvěšována pod bílou vlajkou s písmenem A. 2.3 Signals for course Bravo will be displayed below a white flag with the letter B. Znamení pro okruh bravo budu vyvěšována pod bílou vlajkou s písmenem B. 2.4 When the AP is hoisted ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in the race signal AP.</p>
3	<b>SCHEDULE OF RACES</b>
	<p>3.1 For classes ILCA 7, ILCA 6 and Europe, 12 races are scheduled. For classes Finn, RS Vareo, 420, Fireball and Cadet, 8 races are scheduled</p> <p>For the validity of the regatta, at least one race must be finished. For the validity of the 12mr and 7P koeficients at least 3 races must be finished.</p>

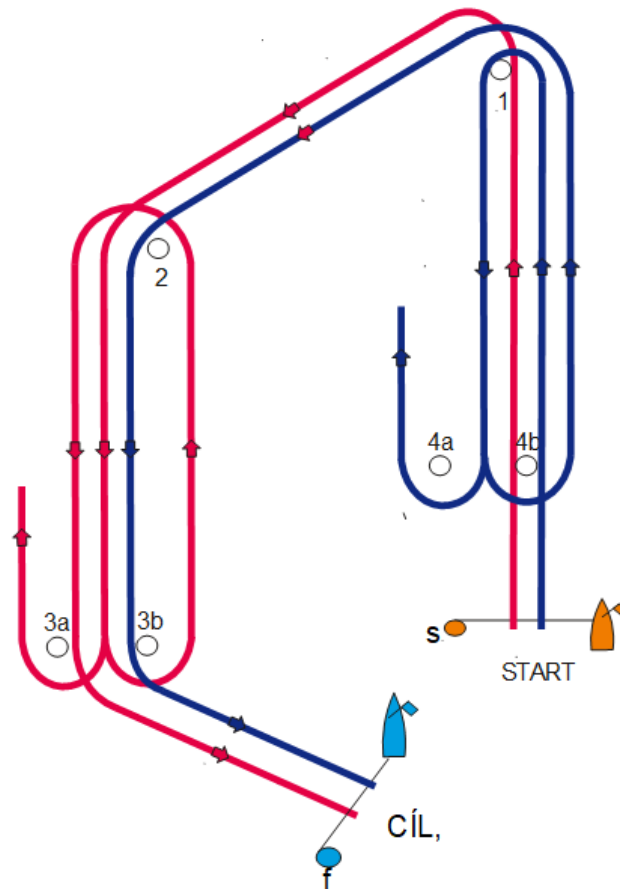

6	<b>MARKS</b>
	Marks are described in SI Appendix A.
7	<b>THE START</b>
	<p>7.1 A boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS). This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.  7.2 [NP] No races will be started if the winds speed is below 5 knots.  7.3 The start line will be between: (a) two flagpoles with orange flags on RC vessels, or (b) flagpole with orange flag on RC vessel (starboard side) and windward side of the startmark (port side) as stated in appendix A of the SIs.</p>
8	<b>PENALTIES</b>
	<p>8.1 RRS Appendix P will be applied during the regatta.  8.2 RRS Appendix T will be applied during the regatta.</p>
9	<b>TIME LIMITS</b>
	<p>9.1 Race time limit Alfa is 70 minutes.  9.2 Race time limit Bravo is 70 minutes.  9.3 [NP] Finishing Window is 15 minutes.</p>
10	<b>SCORING</b>
	(a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

	<p>(b) When 4 to 7 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.</p> <p>(c) When 8 and more races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.</p>
11	<b>[DP][NP] SAFETY</b>
	Sailors below the age of 18 shall wear their personal floating devices at all times while on the water, with exception of needed physical needs and changing clothes as long they are not racing.
12	<b>SUPPORT BOATS</b>
	<p>12.1 Authorization of the operation of support boats is governed by the Notice of race. All support boats have to be registered with the Race Committee.</p> <p>12.2 Support boats shall avoid the racing area of all fleets and shall not obstruct racing boats.</p> <p>12.3 Race area is outlined with marks of the course.</p> <p>12.4 Infingement of the rules 12.2 and 12.3 may result in disqualification of the supported boats.</p> <p>12.5 The rule 12.4 doesnt apply in rescue operations, which are signaled by hoisting „V“ (ICS Victor) without sound signal on the RC vessel. If possible, support boats will be notified on the VHF channel 72.</p>

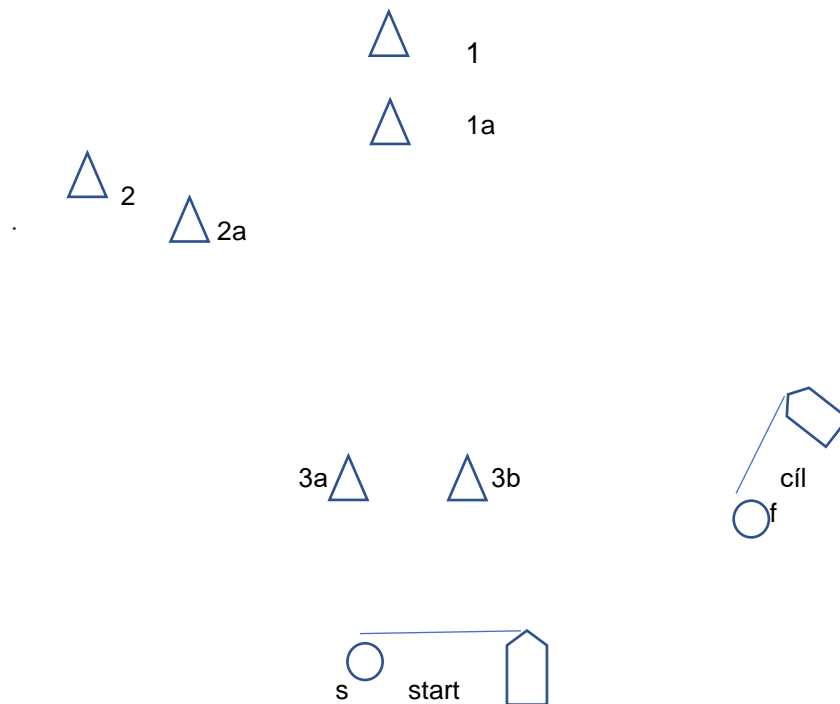

This changes RRS 33.</p>
